

Oak Moth Quilt Supply List

Student Prerequisites: Must have a working knowledge of sewing machine, sewing/quilting experience, how to use a rotary cutter and ruler. Accurate cutting skills and piecing skills.

Supplies:

Please cut your fabric according to attached pattern instructions before class and mark the pieces with A, B, etc. and place each in a separate sandwich bag.

SUPPLY LIST:

Oak Moth Quilt Pattern by Pen Paper Patterns

Fabric:

Colors 1 and 3: Kona fabric Foxglove and Overcast or equivalent – ½ yard of each

Colors 2 and 4: Kona fabric Spice and Lighthouse or equivalent – Fat Quarter or ¼ yard of each

Color 5: Kona fabric Burgundy or equivalent – Fat Quarter or ¼ yard

Color 6-9: Kona fabric Grass Green, Wasabi, Bonsai and Forest or equivalent – ½ yard of each

Background: Kona fabric Haze or equivalent – 3 ½ yards

Backing: 4 ¾ yards

Binding: ½ yard

Sewing machine in good working order

Thread

Iron and Ironing mat (Optional)

Pins

Scissors

Cutting Mat

Rotary Cutter

10-inch square ruler

BASIC INSTRUCTIONS:

Please read through all instructions before beginning

RST = Right Sides Together

WOF = Width of Fabric

Seam allowances are 1/4"

Pattern assumes WOF is 42"

Tags for organizing the cuts of fabric and units are on Page 12

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

FROM COLORS 1 AND 3, CUT:

(2) 4" x WOF strip; subcut into:

A (14) 4" x 3 1/2"

(1) 3" x WOF strip; subcut into:

B (14) 3" squares

FROM COLORS 7 AND 8, CUT:

(3) 4" x 21" strip; subcut into:

C (14) 4" x 3"

FROM COLOR 5, CUT:

(4) 2 1/4" x 21" strip; subcut into:

D (28) 2 1/4" x 2 3/4"

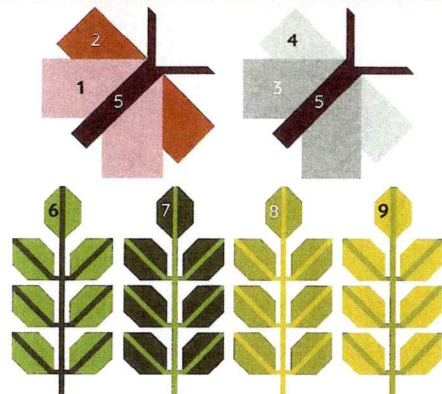
(5) 1 1/2" x 21" strip; subcut into:

E (14) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2"

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THE MOTH BLOCK MEASURES 10" SQUARE UNFINISHED
THE FERN BLOCK MEASURES 10" X 20 1/2" UNFINISHED

FROM COLORS 6 - 9, CUT:

(2) 4 1/2" x WOF strip; subcut into:

F (12) 4 1/2" squares [Cut squares in half on the diagonal]

Trim remnant into (3) 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" and subcut into:

G (12) 1" x 6 1/2"

(1) 2" x WOF strip; subcut into:

H (4) 2" x 5 1/2"

Trim remnant into (1) 7/8" x 20" and subcut into:

I (1) 7/8" x 13"

(1) 1" x WOF strip; subcut into:

J (2) 1" x 20 1/2"

(Cutting instructions cont'd on Page 2)

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS CONT'D:

FROM THE BACKGROUND FABRIC, CUT:

(4) 5 1/2" x WOF strip; subcut into:

K (28) 5 1/2" squares [Cut squares in half on the diagonal]

(2) 5" x WOF strip; subcut into:

L (16) 5" x 2 1/2"

M (32) 5" x 1"

Trim the remnant into (3) 1" x 10" and subcut into:

N (14) 1" x 1 1/2"

(2) 4 1/8" x WOF strip; subcut into:

O (4) 4 1/8" x 13"

Trim the remnant into (2) 1 1/2" x 16" and subcut into:

P (20) 1 1/2" squares

(2) 4" x WOF strip; subcut into:

Q (28) 4" x 2 1/4"

Trim the width of the remnant to 3 1/2" and subcut into:

R (3) 3 1/2" x 5 1/2"

(2) 3 1/2" x WOF strip; subcut into:

R (13) 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" [Combine all R pieces together]

Trim the remnant into (2) 1 1/2" x 9" and subcut into:

P (8) 1 1/2" squares [Combine all P pieces together]

(2) 2 1/2" x WOF strip; subcut into:

S (28) 2 1/2" squares

(2) 2 1/4" x WOF strip; subcut into:

T (28) 2 1/4" squares

(8) 2" x WOF strip; subcut into:

U (156) 2" squares



QUILT FINISHES 57" X 67 1/2"

SASHING AND BORDERS:

(11) 1 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut into:

A (8) 1 1/2" x 10" [Sashing A]

B (9) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" [Sashing B]

C (2) 1 1/2" x 31" [Sashing C]

D (1) 1 1/2" x 41 1/2" [Sashing D]

E Sew the 1 1/2" x 21 1/2" remnant piece from the [Sashing B] step to a 1 1/2" x WOF strip, RST. Trim the pieced strip to 52" long [Sashing E].

(3) 3" x WOF strips; subcut into:

F Trim one of the 3" x WOF strips in half lengthwise. Sew each half to a 3" x WOF strip, RST. Trim each pieced strip to 52" long. [Top & Bottom Borders]

(4) 3" x WOF strips; subcut into:

G Sew two 3" x WOF strips end-to-end, RST. Repeat until you have two pieced strips total. Trim each pieced strip to 67 1/2" long. [Left & Right Borders]
