### **Supply List:**

Creative Grids 4" Curvy Log Cabin (CGRJAW6MINI)

Creative Grids Ultimate Flying Geese Tool (CGRDH4)

Pattern: Boo To You by Deb Heatherly (CLPDHE023)

#### Fabric Requirements:

2/3 yard orange fabric

2/3 yard **EACH** light background and backing fabric

½ yard black for geese and binding

10" square **EACH** black solid and green

6" square brown for stems

½ yard fusible web (Like Steam-a-seam)

### **Cutting Instructions:**

**ORANGE FABRIC** 

Cut (3) 3"x Width of Fabric (WOF)strips for outer border

Cut (12) 1 1/8" squares for curvy log cabin block centers

Cut (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips for curvy log cabin Wide logs

Sub-cut and LABEL the following:

First round (12) 1 1/2" x 1 7/8"

(12) 1 ½"x 2 7/8"

Second round (12) 1 1/2" x 3"

(12) 1 ½" x 4"

Third Round (12) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"

(12) 1 ½" x 5 ¼"

#### LIGHT BACKGROUND FABRIC

Cut (1) 5 ¾" x WOF strip; sub-cut into 5 ¾" squares for geese and (4) 2 ½" Squares

Cut (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip; sub-cut into (1) 3 ½" x 28 ½" rectangle

Cut (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips; sub-cut into (4) 1 ½" x 8 ½" and (1)

1 1/2" x 28 1/2" rectangle

Cut (8) 1 1/4" x WOF strips for curvy log cabin NARROW logs

Sub-cut and LABEL the following:

First Round: (12) 1 1/4" x 1 1/8"

(12) 1 1/4" x 1 7/8"

Second Round (12) 1 1/4" x 2 1/4"

(12) 1 1/4"x 3"

Third Round (12) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2"

(12) 1 1/4" x 4 1/2"

Black Fabric for Geese and Binding

Cut (2) 3 1/4" x WOF strips; sub-cut into (20) 3 1/4" squares

Cut(3) 2 1/2" X WOF for binding

### **Bring to Class:**

- Your machine with foot pedal and power cord.
- Marking pen or pencil
- Thread for applique on letters, leaves and stems
- Fabric scissors
- Rotary cutter with fresh blade
- Cutting mat
- Straight pins, seam ripper and anything else you normally use when sewing
- Basic ruler for trimming and cutting.
- Iron and ironing surface (optional)
- Magic sizing or best press if you use it (optional)
